

Master Soccer Coach

Location: East Otis, Massachusetts **Type**: Private residential soccer camp

Description: The Berkshire Soccer Academy is an overnight soccer camp for girls. We offer an elite training experience for girls, ages 9-16, in a traditional camp setting on a private lake in the Berkshires.

The Master Soccer Coach will work at the Academy for two consecutive weeks of soccer camp that are offered at the Academy. The Master Coach will function under the Soccer Program Director and be responsible for developing and maintaining the soccer training sessions daily. Master Coaches will help to plan and facilitate 2-3 (90-minute) soccer sessions per day, assisted by 1-2 Head Coaches and 4-5 Assistant Coaches while all supervising 20-40 campers at a time on the field. Master Coaches will likely work with the older groups of campers.

Master Coaches will be responsible for developing soccer training sessions and teaching the Assistant Soccer coaches these sessions. A typical day for a Master Coach can begin as early as 7:30AM and end as late as 830PM. This will include writing session plans each evening for the next day. Master Coaches will live in all-staff cabins at camp.

Job Qualifications:

- Must have proven experience supervising a minimum of 10 children at one time
- Must have 4-5 + experience coaching at the elite youth or collegiate level
- Must have NSCAA Junior Level VI Diploma, US Soccer Level %2+License or equivalent
