The Waterfront Director will supervise a waterfront staff of 3-6 lifeguards and instructors to maintain a safe, organized and fun lakefront; supervising shallow and deep-water swimming and water-park play; enforcing all rules and standards; managing equipment and paperwork; cleaning and organizing area; and responding to emergencies. The Waterfront Director will be in charge of camper elective swim sessions for 10-40 campers at one time. The Waterfront Director will be on a leadership team and may also be a Residential Life Leader (see description below) at camp.

There are 4 Residential Life Leaders on the Academys leadership team. Residential Life Leaders will be trained to serve as qualified resources for up to 40 campers and 10 counselors. They will report to and work directly with the Program Directors. Residential Life Leads will live in a staff cabin with other leadership team members. A typical day for a Residential Life Lead may include early-morning and/or late-night meetings, and performing regular wounds+in the cabins.
