Camp Description: The Berkshire Soccer Academy is a private overnight soccer camp for girls. We offer an elite training experience for girls, ages 10-16, in a traditional camp setting on a private lake in the Berkshires.

Scope of Work: When not on Cabin Counselor duty, the Fishing Instructor will plan, prepare, and teach one-hour classes to 5-20 campers 1-2 times daily; manage and organize all materials; and enforce camp rules and standards. A typical day may begin as early as 7:00AM and end as late as 10:00AM. This includes 1 day off for every 6 working days and regularly scheduled breaks throughout the workday. The Fishing Instructor will live in a cabin with 8-12 campers as their Cabin Counselor, alongside 1-2 other counselors. All elective staff members will be responsible for working together to plan and run special camp events.
