Scope of Work: The Turf Management Specialist will work under the Facilities Manager to maintain two natural grass soccer fields and one turf field. This includes, but is not limited to, watering, seeding, grooming, and lining. The Turf Management Specialist will maintain and care for all of the field equipment. A typical day for a Turf Management Specialist can begin as early as 6:30AM and end as late as 8:30PM, which includes 1 day off for every 6 working days and regularly scheduled breaks during the work day. The Turf Management Specialist will live in a staff-only cabin.
