Ralph Ranalli's daughter, Lilly, will be returning this year for her 2nd summer. Ralph is a journalist and videographer, as well as a seasoned girls soccer coach and past President of the Newton Girls Soccer Club, one of the largest girls soccer programs in New England. Ralph conceived and produced The Beautiful Project, a DVD aimed at educating parent coaches on the best ways to coach girls by focusing on their unique needs as distinct from those of boys. The video chapters include helpful demonstrations of female-specific soccer warm-ups and exercises designed to enhance the training experience for girls and to help avoid problems like injuries and burnout.





The Boston Breakers co-sponsored the Beautiful Project. Coaching expertise and support was provided by Boston Breakers Academy Director, Tom Durkin, also a Berky parent. The video, which has the backing of the US Soccer Federation and the National Women's Soccer League, sets the standard for girls-specific coaching.

She was a three-time U.S. Soccer Player of the Year (1993, 2005, 2006), a member of two FIFA Women's World Cup champions and two gold and one silver medal winning Olympic teams. She appeared in 352 international games, the most ever, and captained the U.S. National Team from 2005–2007.

GA-GA IS THE NEW DODGEBALL!

Welcome to BSA's newest fun and highenergy activity: Ga-Ga! Ga-Ga (literally meaning "touch-touch" in Hebrew) is played in an enclosed area called a "gaga pit" and combines dodging, striking, running and jumping.
